


Flagpole Halyard and Fitting



- To fit up to 5m flagpole (10m long rope)**
- To fit 7m flagpole (14m long rope)**
- To fit 10m flagpole (20m long rope)**

Flagmakers stock a comprehensive range of 50mm and 75mm diameter flagpoles. Each flagpole is quality engineered in aluminium, with a white powdercoated finish.

Components Supplied:

Braided Polyester Halyard Rope	1
Flagmakers Sister Clip - Loose	1
Flagmakers Sister Clip - Fitted	1
Rope Crimp - Loose	1

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

(Please read these instructions thoroughly before attempting assembly.)

Before Mounting the Flagpole

- 1) Thread the rope through the pulley in flagpole truck (top)
- 2) If necessary, trim the rope length allowing sufficient length to be off the cleat.
- 3) Heat seal the end of the rope with a small flame.
- 4) Crimp on the second sister clips with pliers.

The halyard forms a continuous "loop" through the pulley with the flag fitted between the Sister Clips.

When no flag is being flown, "close" the loop by joining the Sister Clips on the halyard.

Be careful to hold or secure both ends of the halyard when fitting or removing a flag. Otherwise one end may be blown out of reach by the wind, or may be inadvertently pulled up to the pulley at the top of the pole!


A cord can be run between the ends of a flagpole halyard, or a continuous halyard can be employed to prevent the "loss" of an end. This, however, reduces the benefits of Flagmakers Swivel Clips which are fitted to our flags, and flag "rolling" around the halyard can be a problem with the hoisting.

Ensure the flag is raised to the very top of the flagpole, and with both ends of the halyard.

FLAGMAKERS SISTER CLIPS

In order to benefit from all of the advantages available from Flagmakers Swivel Clips, this halyard has been fitted with Flagmakers Swivel Clips.

To avoid possible damage to flags and/or pole, do not site in very exposed positions, and do not fly flags in excessively strong winds, or fly oversize flags.
